Description:	As mentioned in http://www.nntpgrab.nl/boards/2/topics/257 the Qt frontend currently doesn't remember the last host/port used to connect to a NNTPGrab Server. Due to this, users have to re-enter the host/port again every time they start NNTPGrab
